<b>Opening Activity</b>	
Resources	Australian Flag
Notes on Opening Activities	There should be an Opening and Closing Activity associated with the meeting whether at the den or on camp or away from the den. Wherever possible the Opening and Closing activities of each youth meeting should be led by youth members who have been trained for these roles. Ideally every youth member should be progressively involved in taking an assisting or leading role in an Opening or Closing Activity once a semester. <b>Game</b>	<b>Stuck in the Mud cake</b>
Resources	Nil
Game Play	In a boundary area (the hall/den or other confined space), one Joey Scout is nominated as 'It' They (It) must then run around trying to tag as many other Joey Scouts as they can Once a Joey Scout has been tagged. they then have to stand with their feet shoulder width apart and can only be freed if another Joey Scout crawls between their legs
<b>Activity</b>	<b>Making Butter</b>
Resources	Whipping cream, salt, jar with a lid or a Tupperware container with an airtight lid (one per Joey Scout), strainer
Method	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Pour some heavy whipping cream into your jar That exact amount doesn't matter, aim for the jar to be about half full Make sure the lid is securely in place</li> <li>2. Hand the jar to the Joey Scout and have them shake it - hard and fast for as long as they can As they shake the jar the Joey Scouts will hear the cream sloshing around They will need to shake it for several minutes to get to butter, so it is a good idea to pass it around for other Joey Scouts to shake. Eventually, you will hear the sloshing sound stop – take a peek and you should have whipped cream</li> <li>3. Close the jar again and keep shaking. Eventually, you will hear the liquid sounds start up again.</li> <li>4. You will see a mass start to form in your jar. This is the butter.</li> <li>5. Open your jar and sprinkle in some salt. (Optional, for salted butter.)</li> <li>6. Shake for a little longer, then open your jar</li> <li>7. Taste</li> </ol>

<b>Game</b>	<b>What's in the Kitchen Kim's Game</b>
Resources	Kitchen Utensils – peeler, bowl, knife, fork, measuring cup, wooden spoon etc – (number of items is not limited), tray, towel to cover items, note paper and pencils/pens
Game Play	Just like the 'standard' Kim's Game a tray of items is covered and then revealed for one minute to the Joey Scouts that try and memorise as many of the revealed objects as they can and then covered after 60 seconds Joey Scouts working in pairs try and remember the items under the towel by writing them down or telling the Leader – about 60 seconds to do this. Alternatively uncover the items after about 60 seconds ask the Joey Scouts to close their eyes for 10 seconds and whilst this is happening one object is removed and when the Joey Scouts open their eyes, they have to work out what is missing.
<b>Activity</b>	<b>Muffin Pizzas</b>
Resources	English Muffins (1 packet will make 12 pizzas), pizza sauce or tomato/BBQ sauce, mozzarella cheese, ham, salami, baking trays or aluminium foil, oven Pizza Hut Song Sheet
Method	Give each Joey Scout a muffin half Spoon 1 to 2 tablespoons pizza sauce onto each muffin Top with mozzarella cheese and other available toppings Have the Joey Scouts arrange their pizza on a baking tray Have an adult/Leader put the baking tray in the oven for about 10 minutes Enjoy  <i><b>Note that there may be Joey Scouts that cannot eat the muffins – gluten, lactose or sauce/topping – please adjust ingredients (discuss with parents) to suit so the activity is inclusive</b></i>  While the pizzas are cooking teach the Joey Scouts the ' <b>Pizza Hut</b> ' Song with actions
