	Sorting Activity: Have pictures of foods, games and other activities (including Scouting ones – knot tying for example) that would be possible in a night with adult guests. Don't forget Opening and Closing.		
	On a big piece of paper or a board, have an outline of a usual meeting. Ask the Joey Scouts, in turn, to choose an activity picture and put in on the meeting plan. Allocate Activity Leads as appropriate.		
0:25	Game: In the Oven, On the Pie Joey Scouts stand in a circle or on a line. Leader uses the commands IN the oven or ON the pie. In the Oven = one jump forward On the Pie = one jump backwards On the Oven or In the Pie = freeze		
0:45	Story – Read a food/cooking/pie/Dad themed picture book.		
0:50	Game – Utensil Relay Divide the Joey Scouts into Patrols (relay teams) At one end of the space, the Joeys line up with a stack of utensils. At the other end of the space is the washing up bowl. (Empty or full, up to you) On 'Go' the Joey Scout takes a utensil and goes to the washing up bowl. They 'wash up' the utensil (or just put it in the empty bowl) and return to their team to tag the next player. This game can be played for speed or accuracy, with the drying up being judged.		Cooking utensils and washing up bowls (hopefully Scout Section can lend some) Same numbers for each team. Nothing too sharp. Tea- towels
0:55	Closing Support a Joey Scout to lead the reflection as part of the Closing.	Joey Scout-led reflection
